The Pearce Foundation is a registered charity (charity number 1198611), established to provide financial & personal support to small, fledgling charities and not-for-profit organisations in Sussex to help them meet the needs of their beneficiaries more effectively.

Our Commitment and values

Operations

As a small grant-giving foundation, we operate primarily on a voluntary basis. This ensures that our resources are used in the most efficient and effective way.

Our main working studio has solar panels, which cover the cost of all electricity, including heating. Any surplus electricity is fed back into the grid. We also have a compost bin for any raw food waste, and recycling is collected weekly.

We are committed to sustainability in all aspects of our work. We believe that it is our responsibility to use our resources wisely and to minimise our impact on the environment. We will continue to explore ways to reduce our carbon footprint and to make our operations more sustainable.
